

Information for Submission of Manuscripts, Posters and Presentations Manuscripts:

Articles which are previously unpublished will be accepted (with no more than 30,000 characters with spaces). Articles should address the symposium topics. The symposium will organize a special issue in GEOLOGICA, an International Journal of Earth Sciences in English. The text should be divided into sections: introduction, brief review of the problem, methods, data, analysis, conclusions, acknowledgements, and references. Manuscript shall be prepared in Microsoft Word document (composed on a A4 210 x 297 mm page-setup, with 25 mm margins on top/bottom and left/right, doubly spaced lines, 12 Font size, Times New Romans, with continuous line-numbers shown throughout, and paginated at bottom center). Title will be concise and conveying a strong message regarding the contents (Capitalize, font size-14, bold and centered)

Do not number the pages. Page size – A4; MS Word text editor, single-spaced. At the beginning of the article, the following information is given (each item from a new line):

Title (Times New Roman, 14 pt, black)

Authors

Full name(s) of all authors and their affiliation should be clearly mentioned with at least one author as the corresponding author (provide email of corresponding author).

Abstract:

A short and brief summary (not more than 300 words) that explains the study topic, its contents, methodology, and main results/conclusions, that should be elaborated in details in the main text (Times New Romans, font size 10, typed in italics, centered).

Key words: Provide 3 to 6 keywords (font size 10)

Figures (graphs, photo) should be placed in the text of the article. The quality of the figures should be high. Figures (Fig. 1) can be both black-and-white and colored. All figures' captions and labels should be in place. The thickness of the lines shall be at least 0.15 mm. The size of the text on the figure must correspond to the figure. Figures should be easily readable. Tables (Table 1) should be placed in the body of the article. Table number and title should be placed above the table. The equations created in the Microsoft Equation editor should be numbered. Reference to an equation number is given in the text in parentheses.

The letter designations and abbreviations used in the article should be deciphered at the first mention in the text or expressions to the formulas. Units of measure are specified in the International System of Units.

If cited altogether use semi-colon between/among various authors works following the chronological order (Author1, 2010; Author1 & Author2, 2018; Author1 et al., 2020).

Presentations:

Posters:

Posters are to be presented as A0 or an equivalent area.
